## 1 Overall result of activity

Through Project HomeWorks (PHW) started in previous year, HFHJ also provided the elderly and the handicapped in Tokyo with house repair and cleaning to improve their housing conditions. Through these activities, HFHJ has gained new partners who support its vision, mission and principles. HFHJ also has sent out the message of importance of participatory civil society as well as housing issues in society. Finally, we were given “Nintei” status by Tokyo Metropolitan Government after many years of pursuit.
