1 Overall result of activity

Although the COVID-19 pandemic continued to have a large impact on Habitat Japan throughout FY22, with the cooperation of many supporters and volunteers, we were able to provide assistance in finding housing and improving the environment, including cleaning and repair, to mainly elderly and disabled people living in Tokyo. In addition, leadership training programs for young people were conducted both in person and online. Furthermore, the organization conducted repair activities at eight facilities, including children's homes. Through these activities, the organization expanded its circle of partners who agreed with its philosophy and the significance of its activities, and also communicated to society at large about various housing-related issues and the importance of participation by civil society.
