### **Volunteer Insurance (Aioi Nissay Dowa Insurance)**

All Habitat for Humanity Japan volunteer participants are insured by a comprehensive volunteer insurance program provided by Habitat for Humanity Japan.

To be eligible for this insurance, participants must provide the following information: 1. Their name, 2. Their address, 3. Their phone number, 4. Their date of birth.

Main insurance clauses and their coverage amounts are as follows:

#### **[Accident Insurance]**

- Accidental death ¥20 million
- Accident physical impediment From ¥20 million to ¥800,000
- Hospitalization ¥10,000 / day
- Surgery 5-10x value of daily Hospitalization Insurance
- Outpatient ¥4,500 / day

#### **[Infectious Disease Compensation]**

- Death (condolence payment) ¥1 million
- 31 days or longer of Hospitalization 70,000 yen / day
- 8 to 30 days of Hospitalization 50,000 yen / day
- Less than 8 days of Hospitalization 30,000 yen / day

#### **Process of Insurance Claim**

Any incidents during volunteering will be initially reported to the insurance company by Habitat for Humanity Japan. The following necessary procedures are to be completed by the assured volunteers.
