



Volunteer Insurance (Aioi Nissay Dowa Insurance)

All Habitat for Humanity Japan volunteer participants are insured by a comprehensive volunteer insurance program provided by Habitat for Humanity Japan.

To be eligible for this insurance, participants must provide the following information: 1. Their name, 2. Their address, 3. Their phone number, 4. Their date of birth.

Main insurance clauses and their coverage amounts are as follows:

[Accident Insurance]

Accidental death
¥20 million

Accident physical impediment
From ¥20 million to ¥800,000

● Hospitalization ¥10,000 / day

• Surgery 5-10x value of daily Hospitalization Insurance

• Outpatient ¥4,500 / day

[Infectious Disease Compensation]

• Death (condolence payment) ¥1 million

31 days or longer of Hospitalization 70,000 yen / day
8 to 30 days of Hospitalization 50,000 yen / day
Less than 8 days of Hospitalization 30,000 yen / day

Process of Insurance Claim

Any incidents during volunteering will be initially reported to the insurance company by Habitat for Humanity Japan. The following necessary procedures are to be completed by the assured volunteers.
