Working Site

Medan, North Sumatera, Indonesia

Indonesia has many tourism spots where attract tourists around the world. Indonesia is rich in natural resource and is an



archipelago consisting approximately 17,000 islands.

Indonesia has world 4<sup>th</sup> biggest population and it has experienced strong economic growth in recent years. However, 29% of population has to live less than 1.25 dollars per day and this economic growth is not enjoyed equally. In particular, poverty is concentrated among rural households and there are many families who cannot live in decent houses.

This team will work in village named Sei Beras Sekata, where is located 10 kilometers from the airport of Medan, capital city of North Sumatera. Population of this village is 5,564, and 269 families out of total 1,359 households are considered that they live under poverty. Also in this village, 1,359 families live in 1,000 houses and 70% of the houses are considered as non-decent homes. Many houses are lacking at proper sanitation facilities. Children are at a high risk of water-borne diseases and dengue fever due to the poor hygiene and sanitation condition.

Habitat Indonesia targets to improve living conditions of 125 families with low incomes in Sei Beras Sekata by November 2012. On this trip, we visit this village and help improving living condition together with local families.
